  - Weapons – Is everyone CCW licensed and does anyone need a firearms course? If so, we have an NRA licensed instructor who will travel in the area to accommodate instruction.**
  - Bugging In – Concluded in July. When should we schedule the next one? Possibly a January bugging in drill?**
  - Security – Completed in September. One Lecture, one event.**
  - Canning and Harvesting Events – October and November will have events posted by Jo, Co-Leader, Reno Area.**
  - Communications – Wednesday nights at 8:00 PM on the SNARS linked repeater system. We are able to cover all of our areas with this system. Please continue to work on gaining your HAM operator licenses. License study course available on line at reasonable cost at: <http://www.hamradiolicenseexam.com/> The HAM radio clubs also have HAM Cram sessions with times being posted on our site.**

- ix. Pandemic Preparation – Completed in June.**
- x. Group assistance – Interest posted on the site about this. Due to the size of the group and the intention of giving support to fellow Preppers in the area we will need to start putting together a team that can take lead on developing Group Member Emergency Assistance Kits. These would be small kits to be delivered to members in case of localized disasters or emergencies. These kits will contain some food, water, medical, light gear and enough to keep our members going for a couple/few days until they can get on their feet. This can be posted for more open discussion on the Meetup Discussion Board. Jerry produced a great starting point list of items.**
